- Follow essential rules when issuing the Vehicle Shopping Rule.
- Do its homework or adequately study the auto market.
- Consumer test any of its new mandated requirements.
- Provide an accurate breakdown of the costs and benefits of the rule.



Adds at least **another hour** to the car buying process.



Will cost at least **\$1.3 billion** of lost time per year for customers.



More paperwork, red tape, and unnecessary recordkeeping of consumer texts will cost **\$2.4 billion** a year.

Everything this rule seeks to address is already illegal.

Cosponsor the Bipartisan FTC REDO Act (H.R. 7101/S. 3014) to stop this flawed rule and ensure the FTC follows its own regulatory safeguards if it chooses to redo the rule.
